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Course Description: The purpose of the intervention class is to support students in academic success. Curriculum will focus on developing a specific problem solving strategy, basic math skills and application. The goal of this course is to help each student improve their math skills and gain confidence in their ability.

Grading Policies: 70% of the student's grade will be based on Math Daily Work, this includes active participation and in class curriculum completion. 30% will be based on mastery checkpoints. Upon successful completion of this course the student will earn 0.5 elective credits per semester.
