It shall be the responsibility of the contractor to notify their subcontractors and/or suppliers of the clarifications, modifications, and/or revisions included herein.

SPECIFICATIONS

Item 1: Insert the Prevailing Wage Section

PREVAILING WAGE

No contract, sub-contract, agreement, understanding or other arrangement, whether oral or written, between an outside contractor(s) and/or sub-contractor and the School District for the construction or remodeling of any building, or part thereof that exceeds \$2,000.00 and involving craftsmen, mechanics, laborers, asphalt pavers, or masonry contractors employed directly upon the site of work, shall be entered into, approved or executed, unless such contract, sub-contract, agreement, understanding of arrangement shall provide and require that all craftsmen, mechanics, laborers, pavers or masons so employed shall receive not less than the wage and fringe benefits rates prevailing in the locality in which the work is to be performed for corresponding classes of workers.

Such contract, sub-contract, agreement, understanding or arrangement between said outside contractor(s) and the School District shall provide that the contractor(s) and/or sub-contractor(s) engaged in performance of service or work for the School District, to which this policy applies, shall, at the request of the Board, Superintendent, or his designee, furnish proof satisfactory to the Board that the prevailing wages and fringe benefits are being paid.

Any contractor refusing to comply with this policy or refusing to provide satisfactory documentation of compliance with this policy will be removed from the eligible bidder's list. Contractors shall be responsible for the compliance of their sub-contractors. Thus, if a sub-contractor refuses to comply with this policy and/or refuses to provide satisfactory documentation of compliance with this policy, the contractor and sub-contractor will be removed from the eligible bidders list.
