Science fair boards galore! If you walked in the gym on March 31, you would have seen many boards all around the gym.

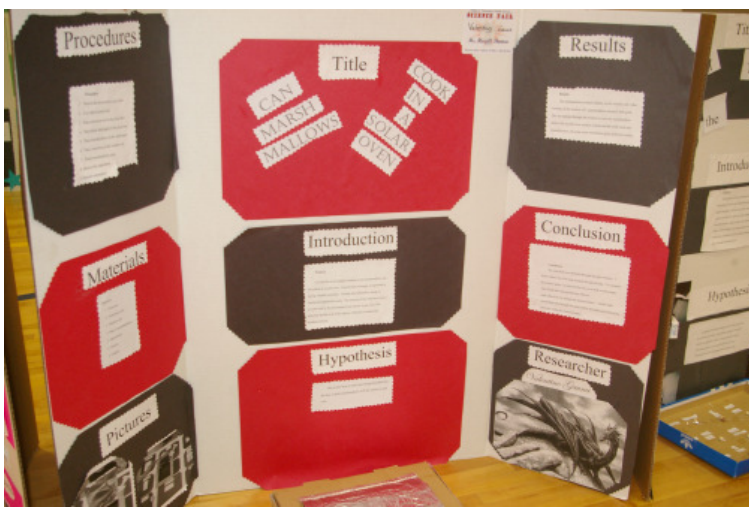
